Services providing mental health care in deprived areas of 14 EU capital cities were assessed with a questionnaire. We analysed availability and accessibility of substance abuse treatment for people from six groups: the long term unemployed, the homeless, street sex

workers, asylum seekers and refugees, irregular migrants and people from travelling communities.
